



## PROBATE OR THE ADMINISTRATION OF ESTATES

The term “**Probate**” is often used to describe the process of dealing with (or administering) the assets (or Estate) of someone who has died. Depending on the size of the estate and the assets involved you may need to obtain a Grant of Probate which is the name of the formal document issued by the Probate Registry, after someone has died leaving a Will, to show that the Will is valid.
