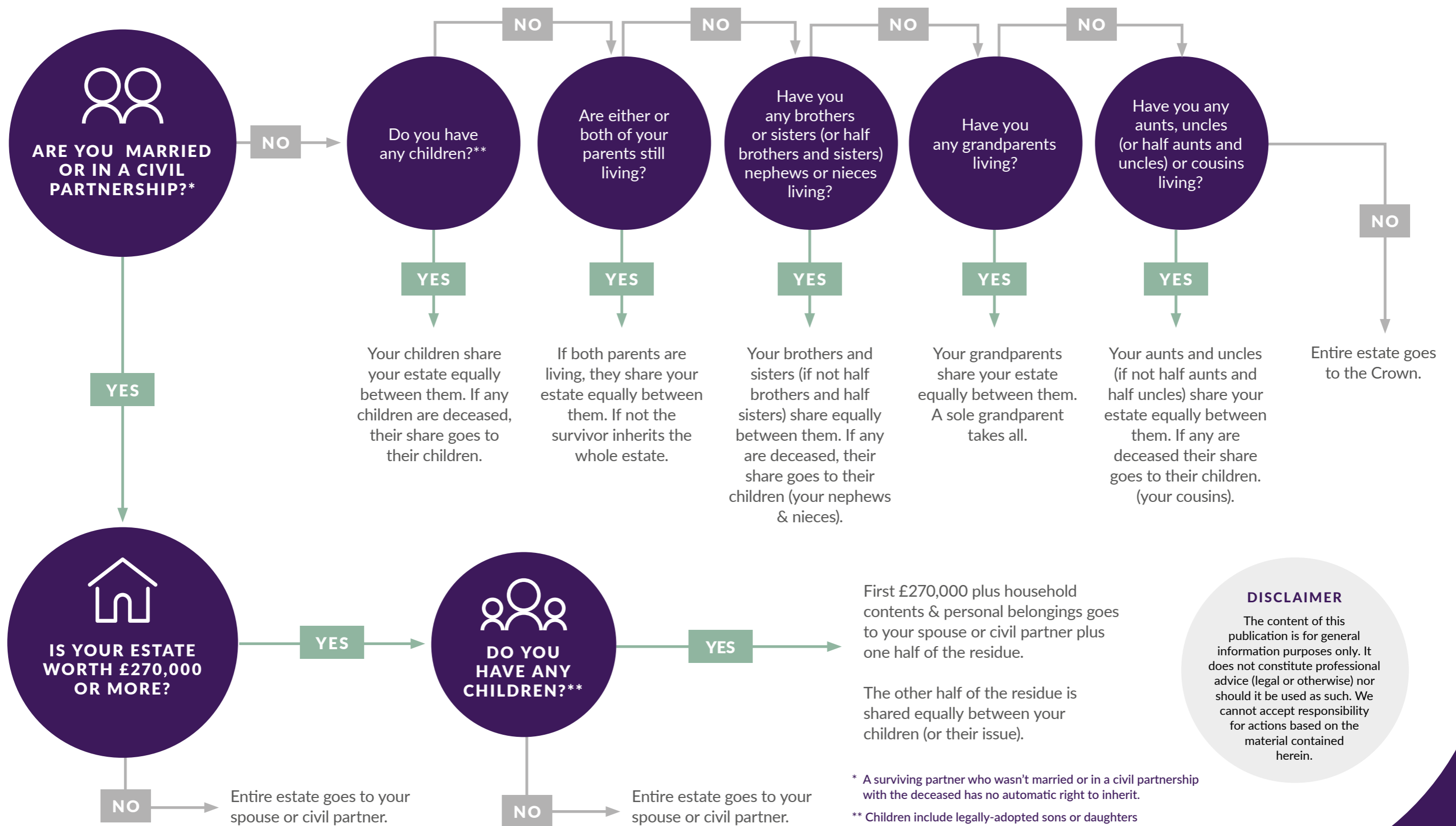


The Rules of Intestacy
